1- Except for the incident with a new owner the other evening that Carol dealt with, the pool has continued to be very quiet with seasonal owners and renters away. There have been a few visitors who have come down to enjoy the pool.

2- The new pool fence has been approved by the city inspector. Patrick and Carol have placed white marble chips around the entire interior of the fence to ensure that only a 2 inch approved gap remains. Many thanks to Patrick and Carol for their work on this project. The new pool fence is a nice addition to the area.

3- The new lock - and new pool key - use still needs to be monitored. When coming to the pool - and someone is in the pool area - the entry door is unlocked. If no one is in the pool area - then the lock needs to be unlocked. When leaving the pool area - if someone is still in the pool area - no need to lock the gate. However - if someone is the last person to leave the pool area - then the gate must be locked when leaving. This procedure will no doubt take some time getting use to - especially when residents and renters arrive in the coming months. Carol mentioned she would send an e-mail blast out regarding the new lock procedure.
