Items discussed were:

Unit 514 has an offer; units 652 & 654 are on the market. Rentals for next year include 428 &617. No application fee will be required for unit 621since Ralph Peragine is a returning renter.

Buildings: The yellow warning bar on the treads of concrete steps should be repainted with more slip-resistant paint in some instances around the property. (Condo stairs). There are 3 vendor bids coming in to replace several gutters at the villas. There is a roof leak at unit 514. Estimates are coming in for roofing G & E are expected. And the roof over building G stairs needs work. Bob H. mentioned he does follow and updates a roof analysis chart. Friends plumbing will be checking the sink of 507 with a camera to check if there is a problem with a pipe beneath the floor. The Association is responsible for pipes under the floor. Letter to owners at 623 for Ken of Homeworks to enter and place a post.

Pool: Cover has been thrown out; new chairs and replacement chairs are on the pool deck; A survey is needed for the pool fence.

Grounds: Sprinklers had a valve issue, Bob H. & Patrick working on a drip line. The Wagner's took advantage of the free tree give away.

Work Orders: 516 requested roots to be trimmed by the building. It is acceptable by the City of Tarpon if the roots are 3 inches and smaller. 423 has an issue with plant watering from 424.

Finance: Paul Lundberg is working on our insurance policy.
