

Windrush plant/bush guide 2013/2014

variegated arboricola -Shrub-does well in sun or shade.

Plant 2 – 2 ½ feet apart. Can be

Kept at 2 ½ - 3 feet tall



Jathropa- bush Bush-blooms 365 days/year. Thrives in full/partial sun or partial shade.

Grows 7-8 feet, but can be maintained 3-4 feet.



Hibiscus bush- Hedges-Need 4-5 hours of sunlight/day. 3-7 feet tall. Can be stand alone too.



Vibernum suspensum -Shrub- needs sun, flowers in March.
Can grow to 11 feet tall.



Loroptalum- Hedges-sunny to partial shade.
10-15 feet tall.



Dwarf fire bush- Hedges-fully sun or partial shade.
5-8 feet tall. Can be stand alone too.



Petra croton- Shrub-6-8 feet tall, spread 3-6 feet.
Year round color. Full sun or partial
Shade.



Knock out roses (red or pink) -Accent foundation-3-4 feet tall with
3-4 feet spread. All day sun.



Dracaena marginata-Tree-moderate to bright sunlight.
10-15 feet tall, 3-8 feet wide.



Golden drew drop- Shrub-10-15 feet tall, 6-10 feet
Spread. Full sun only.



Blue Plumbeo

Tai plant -Colorful foliage plant-4-12 feet
Plant 24-36 inches apart. Full sun
To partial shade.
