- 2. Building Maintenance waiting for estimate from Homeworks for stucco work "L"& "B" building. In addition, new stairs needed for building "N". Violations of several owners concerning storage under the stairs; prevents maintenance from checking on the stability/ repair of the stairs; roof warranties needed for "O" & "D" buildings; water shut off needed for whole community in early Jan. to replace a water shut off handle on the outside of a villa. Possible other replacement valve work to be done at the same time. Bids needed for the villa painting Letters to go out to the villa owners in preparation for the painting work to be done in October 2018. Sheds need to be repaired, shrubs & plants need to be cut back away from the buildings.
- 3. Pool lattice to hide pool pumps & lift station
- 4. Grounds -

Seawall - moving ahead

Sprinklers - new map created showing the extra valves

Landscaping - free mulch coming to use away from the buildings; owners should check with the committee before they plant shrubs or flowers.

5. Work Orders - owners should call Ameritech or place a work order electronically. remove Patricks name with the clubhouse telephone number from the phone book.

Finance - looking for the bills on the tree trimming line item; assessment checks are done once a week at Americtech, owners may see a delay when their checks clear.

Other - Workshop meeting on December 26th, 2017 waived Animal control - large animals seen on property during the day; traps were set, 3 possums were caught. \$199.00 to reset traps. Will wait to see if needed.
