VILLA SHED GUIDELINES

<u>Request</u>

- 1. Written request is presented to the Board for the addition of a shed.
- 2. Board approval required for project to proceed.

Compliance

- 1. Compliance with City of Tarpon Springs adopted Building Codes.
- 2. Compliance with Windrush Bay Condo Association guidelines on dimensions, materials and structure design.
- 3. Building Committee to provide superintendence for all shed projects.

Materials

Base: 1. 4" poured concrete slab with sill anchors.

Framing: 1. Pressured treated 2" x 4" frame lumber.

- 2. $\frac{1}{2}$ " marine plywood.
- 3. ¹/₄" cement hardy board using a T-111 board pattern
- 4. Shed to be anchored to Villa walls.
- 5. Maximum shed dimensions 5 ¹/₂ ft. x 10 ft.

Roofing: 1. 2"x 4" pressure treated rafters with hurricane roofing clips.

- 2. $\frac{1}{2}$ " marine plywood.
- 3. Tar paper.
- 4. Shingling matching Villa roof shingles.
- 5. Shed roof flashed under Villa roof overhang.
- Vents: 1. (1) Wall vent over doorway and (1) sidewall vent.
- Paint: 1. Paint (provided by the Association) to match Villa walls and trim.

Exceptions to these Guidelines must be presented to the Building Committee for approval *before* implementation.
